Branch 1: Creation and covenant The focus of this branch is Revelation. The revelation of Creation is the first step towards the covenant God forges with his people (CCC 288). Branch 2: Prophecy and promise The focus of this branch is for pupils to develop an early understanding of the Christian belief that God showed us the full depth of his love by sending Jesus his Son (CCC 65-66).	Branch 3: Galilee to Jerusalem The focus of this branch is for pupils to develop an early understanding of the Christian belief that through the ministry of Jesus, some of those who encountered him recognised he was the Son of God. Branch 4: Dessert to garden For pupils, the focus of this branch is to learn a little about the season of Lent as a time to prepare for Easter and to know the story of the last week of Jesus' life, his death, and resurrection.	Branch 5: To the ends of the Earth In this branch, pupils will hear the story of the Road to Emmaus, the Ascension, and the story of Pentecost. Branch 6: Dialogue and encounter In the branch, pupils have the opportunity to o develop a sense of Catholic identity within their locality and connect to the wider Christian family. This includes studying other faiths (Judaism).
