Phonics

We will be consolidating phonic knowledge and revising earlier phases as necessary. On the Year 1 Google Classroom you will find Parent Information Resources linked to the Year 1 Phonics Screening Assessment. Any practise you can do at home of "real" and "alien" words to make sure the phonic knowledge is in place for your child, would be much appreciated.

Reading

The Bug Club scheme continues with us refreshing the books every week. Please keep using the website for any extra reading practise. Fluent reading is the key to EVERYTHING so please make this a daily pleasure!

<u>Literacy</u>

We will be studying the text "10 Things I Can Do To Help the World" by Melanie Walsh. It does what it says on the tin (!) and will give us lots of opportunities to write for purpose in non fiction and fiction formats.

<u>Spellings</u>

The weekly spellings will be taken from the Spelling Shed scheme and will revisit and reinforce many of the phonic rules and strategies learned so far. Test will be on a Friday morning and new list will be sent home each Friday.

<u>Numeracy</u>

We are covering multiplying and dividing this half term followed by an introduction to fractions.

<u>Geography</u>

The children will be learning about the oceans of the world.

<u>Science</u>

Our Science topic is Plants. We will be finding out about growing lots of different plants and their structure and uses.

Art and DT

We will be exploring collage, using different media and materials.

<u>R.E.</u>

The children will be learning about the Resurrection and the events following it. <u>**PE**</u> will be on Tuesdays and Fridays as usual and will be outside as much as possible.
