

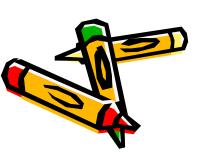



Numeracy


- Mental number work

- Becoming confident mathematicians with a deep understanding of number






Literacy


- Based around the Power of Reading scheme

Physical Education


- P.E. is taught twice a week.

- PE kits will be sent home at the end of each half term for washing.






SATs

- In Year 2, children have to sit SATs assessments in May in Literacy and Numeracy.
- Please don't worry about them!
- The children will be very used to being assessed and will be oblivious to the fact they are sitting SATs.
- In class, I will call them quizzes. In previous years, my classes have loved doing them. They will be very well prepared and ready to do them.




Homework

- Every Friday, the children will bring home a spelling sheet. This should be completed and returned by the following Friday when the children will be tested.
- Children will also be tested on their times tables -2x, 10x, 5x then later on in the year we will move on to 3x and 4x.
- Please read with your child daily, make a note in the diary as the children earn house points for regular reading, and return the diary to school every day.



PACT (Parents and Children and Teachers)


- Children must bring their book bags in everyday. The diary is checked by a member of staff daily and the books changed <u>weekly</u>.
