

Reception Termly Newsletter

Welcome back! We hope you had a lovely restful break and are looking forward to an exciting Spring term.

We will be continuing to upload observations to tapestry and we have loved seeing what you are getting up to at home as well! We will also

be continuing with the weekly newsletters to update you on what we have been doing.

Within this newsletter you will find information regarding what topics we will be covering for the second term of the year and what we will be covering in our areas of learning.

Firstly, some important notices:

Please ensure that your child's clothing is clearly labelled with their name. This includes their PE Kit and shoes if possible.

Please could you make sure that your child has a water bottle in school every day, again making sure that it is clearly labelled. If your child is having packed lunches please ensure this is labelled too.

Our PE day is a Friday so children can come into school in their PE kits all day. Jewellery needs to be removed.

The children just need to bring their blue school book bag to school each day which will have their red phonics book, reading diary and book. These need to be in school each day. Within reception we do encourage that you leave a bag at school with spare clothes in — in case the children need to change. These bags can be taken home every half term.

The children will have access to the garden every day, in all weathers. Please provide your child with a pair of wellies that can stay at school. If you wish you may also provide some waterproofs that your child can keep at school too.

Due to the need to ventilate our classrooms please ensure that your child has layers on as the weather is unpredictable! This could be a vest, plain white t-shirt under their school polo or a plain navy fleece/cardigan, or all three if it is a very cold day. We would encourage the children wear jogging bottoms and you could put tights/leggings and long socks underneath.

If there is a change to pick up arrangements it is vital that you let us know via email.

Curriculum notices:

Phonics — Here at St Marys we follow Phonics Bug.

This term we will be learning our phase 3 sounds whilst consolidating our phase 2 sounds. We will also be revisiting phase I by the games and activities we use with the children. We will be continuing to learn 4 sounds a week, a new sound Monday to Thursday and consolidation of these sounds on a




Friday. The children will also be learning new tricky words and how to spell these. We will continue to update the red phonics books on a Thursday, please make sure the books are in school on a Thursday so this can happen.

Our RE topic for the first half term is Getting to know Jesus. Within this topic the children will be learning about how Jesus has a great love for all of us and how we can show our love for him. We will also be looking at some miracles and reflecting on how Jesus can help us. After the half term our RE topic will be Sorrow and Joy. Within this topic we will be looking at how we can be kind and helpful to each other.

Learning about how Jesus forgave those who hurt him and be aware that we can forgive others. Towards the end of term we will be looking towards Easter and talking to the children about Good Friday.

For reading we will continue to set books and games on Bug club. Please remember that these books are set at your own child's level.

from half term until Easter. Over the next two pages you will see a breakdown of all the curriculum areas and what we will be focusing

on.

Topic — Earth & Beyond.

We will be looking at this topic from the beginning of term until the February half term.

Within the topic we will be looking at our solar system and learning all about the planets. We will also be learning about being an astronaut and even have our own astronaut training day!

Topic - Transport

We will be looking at this topic from half term until the Easter holidays.

Within the topic we will look at how plants and animals grow and change. We will also be looking at how humans grow and change.

We will be thinking about how we the world has changed and what the future might look like.

Literacy

We will be focusing on a variety of fiction and non-fiction books within this topic. We will be writing captions, sentences and simple stories/non-fiction fact files.

We will continue to learn through play for lots of our maths.
