- Articulate ideas and thoughts using well-formed sentences.




- Develop their sense of responsibility and membership as part of the class community.

Physical Development


- Continue to develop movements, such as balancing, riding, hopping and skipping.

Phonics

SPECIFIC AREAS

Literacy

- Develop our phonological awareness. Spotting and suggesting rhymes, recognise words with the same initial sound.
- Using print and letter knowledge to form early writing.
- Write some letters accurately.













- Read individual letters by saying the sounds for them

Mathematics

- Link numerals and amounts, showing the right number of objects to match the numeral up to 5.
- Compare quantities using language more than, fewer
 - Talk about and explore 2D shapes.
 - Understand and use positional language.

Understanding the World

- Talk about different materials and changes they notice.
- Talk about different countries in the world and talk about the differences they see.
- Recognise that life between this country and others are different.
 - Talk about members of their families and community.

Expressive Arts & Design

- Imagintive and complex 'small world' play with blocks and construction materials
- Explore different materials freely to develop ideas about how to use them and what to make.
 - Explore and engage in music making and dance.
