Mrs Ling:

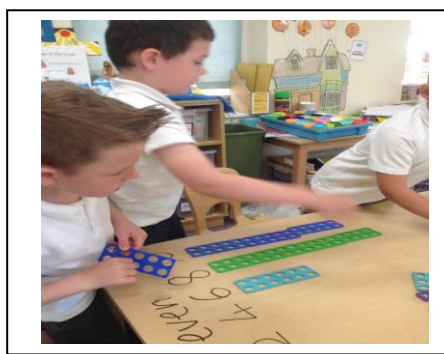

Pupils over the age of 5 - If you wish your child to have milk at morning break please see the attached leaflet with details of how to register and pay.

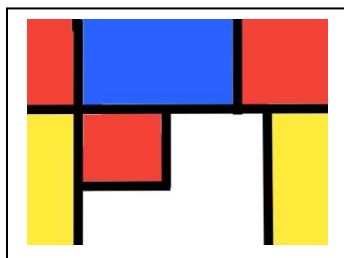
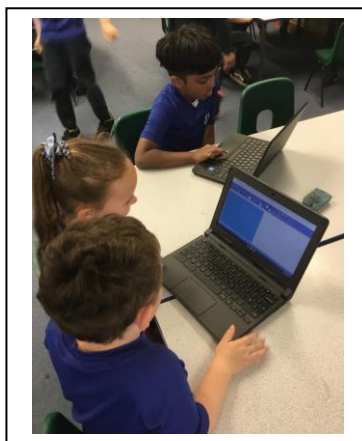
Year R:

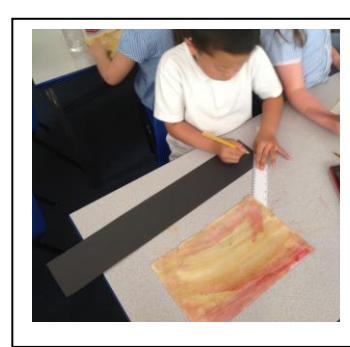
Year 1:

The cricket coach came to St. Mary's on Monday and we had our first session around how to throw and catch the ball with accuracy.



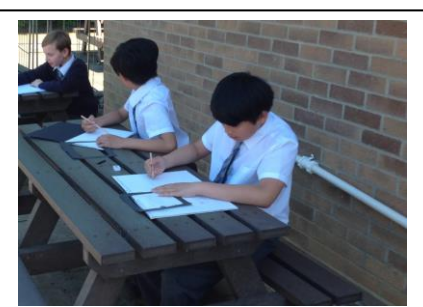
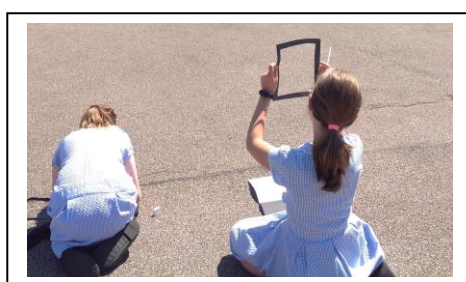
Year 5:
