# Coronavirus Advice – The following information has been sent to us from Suffolk County Council ALL SCHOOLS:

You will be aware of the current and ongoing situation regarding the novel coronavirus (2019-nCoV) outbreak in China as well as across the world. Most reported cases are at the mild end of the spectrum and currently in the UK there are two confirmed cases being treated in line with robust infection control measures.
