#### **RECEPTION 2020/21**

If you are applying for a Reception place starting in September 2020, please send your application to Suffolk County Council (Admissions) before midnight on 15<sup>th</sup> January 2020.

We require a completed Supplementary Information Form (SIF) to be in school by 15<sup>th</sup> January 2020. This form is important and is part of the process when the governors are considering your application to St Mary's School.

If the SIF is not in school by the deadline date, the application will be classed as 'late'.

#### Starting the school day:
