#### How do I order?

- We will work through the requests in order logo items such as PE tops and jumpers are always in demand so if needed we will limit these to one of each per family.
- We will confirm what we can offer you and send you a total price.

## How do I pay?

• Please send in the money with your child, in a sealed named envelope, write their name and 'For the PTA' on the front. It will be passed to the school office.

#### How will I receive my order?

Once payment has been logged, we will send your order home discreetly with your child.

#### What else do I need to know?

- If you are struggling with access to uniform, please let the school office know as we may be able to help.
- Items will be quarantined but we still recommend you launder them on receipt.

Please bear with us. We are doing our best to continue the provision, the stock is held on the school grounds and we cannot access it until all the children have left. This means a return trip to get orders sorted out and it will take longer than you may be used to.
