The children in Reception have enjoyed exploring a range of learning over the first half term of school. The children have been spending lots of time getting to know each other and the routines of school. Our topic for the first half term has been all about us, we have been talking about our families, talking about how we have changed from babies and learning about different body parts.

Reception start their day with a carousel of activities which encourage sharing, discussion and build hand/eye coordination skills.
