



In D.T, we have been creating beeswax wraps. The children designed their own wrap and then had a go at brushing the beeswax over their wraps. They are very excited to bring these home and see if they work!

In gymnastics, we have been looking at individuals ways we can improve our balancing, rolling, travelling and climbing.



In history, we have been really interested in our Stone Age topic! We have learnt all about the 3 periods of Stone Age and the differences between each one. We have just moved onto learning about the Bronze Age and have been comparing the artefacts from this time to Stone age.



In RE, we have been learning about the Kingdom of God. Children have been thinking about the ideal behaviours in the Kingdom and what it would look like. We have also learnt about the story of the lost sheep and the good Samaritan and have created beautiful pieces of artwork that are up on display in the hall and our classroom.

In Maths, we have been looking multiplication, division and fractions. We have learnt how to multiply 2 digit numbers by 1 digit and have been looking at the short division method for division. For fractions, we have learnt how to order unit fractions. With Mrs Dyer, we have been looking at time and shape. We have learnt to use the 12 and 24 hour clock, as well as looking at duration of events in our day. We have also been discovering angles, lines and measuring and how tricky it can be to be accurate.

We have been reading Sam Wu and have really enjoyed the characters in it, which have made us laugh. We also love the way the book has been set out and have used the influences in the book to guide our thoughts and opinions about overcoming our fears and our love, or not of camping.

In Science, we have moved on from animals and humans to looking at forces. We have experimented with friction and seen which surfaces cause the most friction. We have also looked at magnets and have enjoyed our experiments with these!

In PE, we have being focusing on ball skills with Mr Hurd and Miss Godbold. We have been working hard to try to be team players and to apply our skills learnt to mini games.

In PSHE, we have been looking at Safer Internet Day and Mental Health Week. We have learnt about AI and how to keep safe online. We thought about what is appropriate to share online and what is not. We have also looked at stories about the prodigal son.
