Punctual Arrival:

A polite reminder that you and your child need to be in your correct zone at the correct time ready for the start of the school day. Any child that arrives late will need to wait, with a parent, in the correct zone until we can safely let you into school at <u>8.55am</u>.

Zones:

If you are driving to school please be considerate and vacate your parking space as quickly as possible to enable more parents to park and drop their child at school.
