An overall or old tee-shirt is needed for art and craft activities.

Children with shoulder length hair (boys and girls) should have their hair tied back and held out of their eyes. No extreme hairstyles, including etched designs, are allowed for school.

Lost Property

PLEASE ENSURE THAT ALL ITEMS OF CLOTHING ARE CLEARLY MARKED WITH THE CHILD'S NAME.

We do not keep a traditional 'lost property' box, but try to return unclaimed items as soon as possible to their owners – this is only possible if there are names on the items.

Unclaimed items are eventually thrown away or give to the Parent Teacher Association for re-cycling.

Jewellery

Jewellery is not appropriate for school wear. Pupils with pierced ears may wear small studs but these need to be removed for P.E. If a child is unable to remove their earrings due to initial healing time, micropore tape (or equivalent) needs to be provided for the child to cover their earrings.
